## Task 3.1 Preparation of web modules-Development of new learning materials

- *Sustainable Agriculture and Food Systems*
- *Sustainable Agricultural Land Management*
- *Water resources exploitation and management*



## **Task 3.1 Preparation of web modules-Development of new learning materials**

The course is designed to help students and academics obtain a diversity of knowledge and skills, both in the classroom and through personal experiences both on and off campus.

Participants will learn to evaluate best management practices, research, and analyze its role using rational and scientific criteria in order to implement the most suitable practices and policies for the water resources protection.
