



#### Description




- The Aristotle University of Thessaloniki is the largest university in Greece.
- The University Campus covers some 23 hectares close to the centre of Thessaloniki.
- It comprises 9 Faculties organized into 39 Schools, as well as 2 independent Schools (a total of 41

Schools).

#### Manpower

- More than 95,000 undergraduate and postgraduate students study at the Aristotle University, 86,000 in undergraduate programmes and 9,000 in postgraduate programmes.
- The Teaching and Research Staff numbers more than 1,900 people professors, associate professors, assistant professors, and lecturers);
- the Scientific Teaching Staff numbers 103; and
- the Special Laboratory Teaching Staff numbers 306 people.



### Supporting




- This is further supported by:

### School of Agriculture - Staff



- The School of Agriculture at present has:
  - 74Teaching and Research Staff members,
  - 2 members of Special Education Staff and
  - 77 members of Special Administrative and Technical Assistance Staff.
- Currently the School also has:
  - 2491 registered undergraduate students,
  - 221 Master of Science students, and
  - ▶ 138 Doctoral degree candidates.

#### School of Agriculture



- The School of Agriculture consists of seven Departments.
- Each of them covers a specific scientific field and offers a specialized degree in each particular field.
- The seven Departments of the School along with their laboratories are as follows:
  - Department of Animal Production (AP)
  - Department of Agricultural Economics (AE)
  - Department of Hydraulics, Soil Science and Agricultural Engineering (HSAE)
  - Department of Food Science and Technology (FST)
  - Department of Field Crops and Ecology (FCE)
  - Department of Horticulture and Viticulture (HV)
  - Department of Plant Protection (PP)




